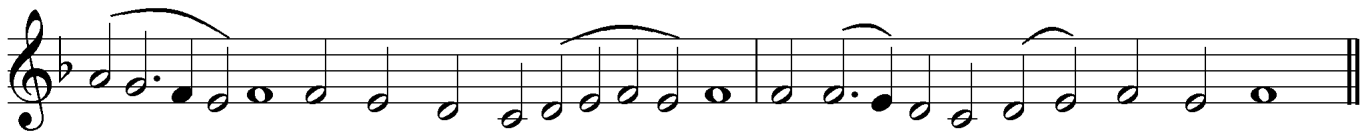

(Greek Chant)

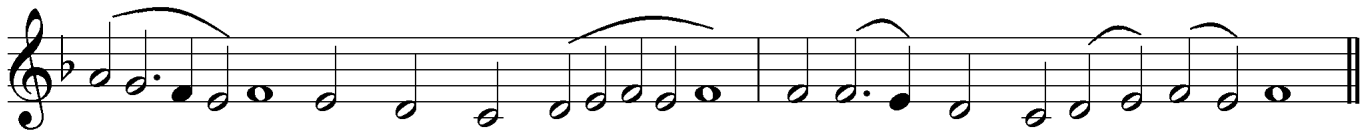


(I) In your king - - - - dom remember us, O Lord, when you come in your king - - dom.

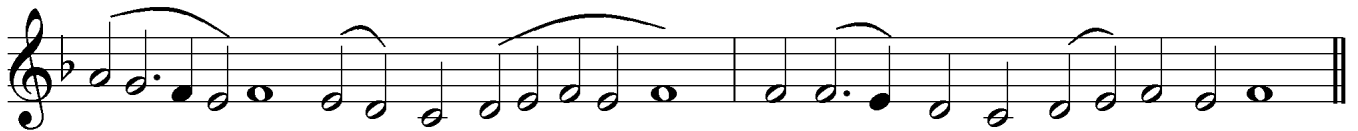


Bless - - - ed are the poor in spir - - - - it, for theirs is the king - dom of heaven.

(II) Bless - - - ed are those who mourn, for they shall be com - fort - ed.

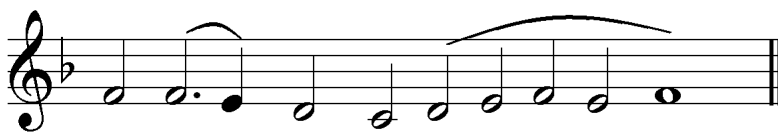


(I) Bless - - - ed are the meek, for they shall in - her - - it the earth.

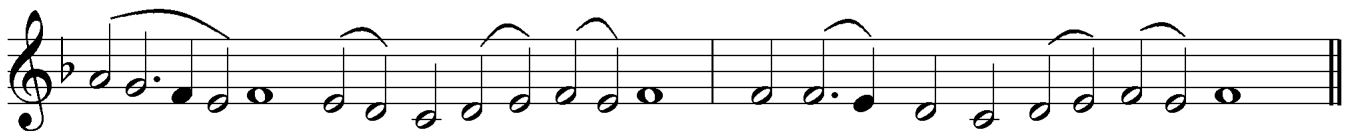
(10 verses begin here)

for they shall be filled.

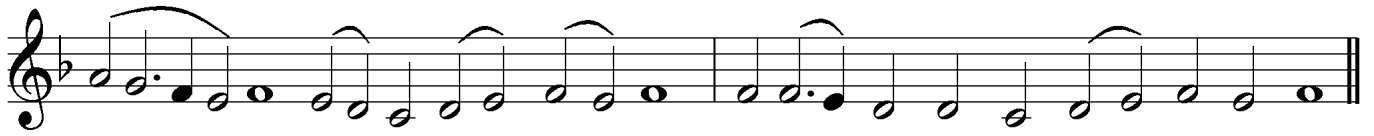


(I) Bless - - - ed are the mer - ci - - ful, for they shall ob - tain mer - cy.

(II) Bless - - - ed are those who are per - se - cut - ed for the sake of right - eous - ness,



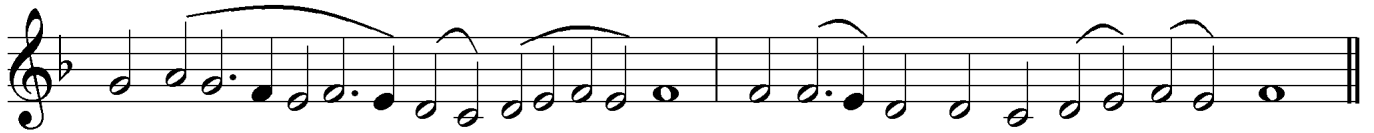

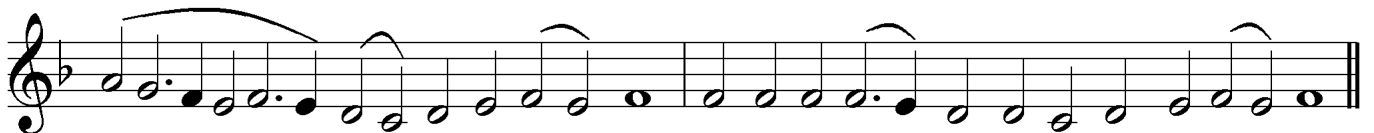
(I) Bless - - - ed are you when they re - vile you and per - se - cute you



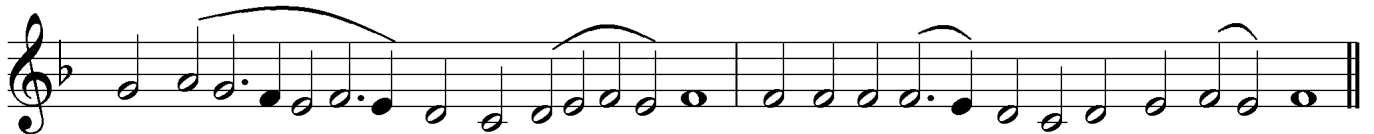
