



Verse: Rejoice in the Lord, you righteous: praise befits the upright.




Verse 1: It is God who gives me revenge, and has subdued peoples under me.

Verse 2: He magnifies the salvation of his king; and shows mercy to his Anointed, to David and his seed for ever.




Verse: The Lord has chastened, he has chastened me, but he has not given me up to death.




Verse 1: May the Lord hear you in the day of trouble; may the name of the God of Jacob shield you.

Verse 2: Lord, save the king, and hear us on the day we call upon you.




Verse: All you nations clap your hands, shout to God with a voice of exultation.





Verse: Bless the Lord, my soul; O Lord my God, you have been greatly magnified.




Verse 1: Bend the bow and prosper and reign, in the cause of truth and meekness justice.

Verse 2: You have loved justice and hated iniquity; therefore God, your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness beyond your fellows.






*Verse*: Save me, O Lord, for there is no holy one left; truths have dwindled from among the sons of men.




Verse 1: I will sing of your mercies, O Lord, for ever; I will proclaim your truth with my mouth from generation to generation.

Verse 2: For you have said: 'Mercy shall be built up for ever', your truth will be established in the heavens.




Verse: To you, O Lord, I cry; my God, be not silent to me.




Verse 1: He who dwells in the help of the Most High will live under the protection of the God of heaven

Verse: Bring to the Lord, O sons of God, bring to the Lord young rams.




Verse 1: It is good to give thanks to the Lord, and to sing praises to your name, O Most High.
